Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered vide FIR No.210 dated 29.11.2018 under Sections 326, 324, 323, and 34 IPC, 1860 at Police Station B-Division, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the parties have in fact entered into a compromise and a petition for quashing of the FIR on the ground of compromise has already been filed in this Court which is presently fixed for 31.05.2019.

The aforesaid position is not disputed by the learned State counsel.

In view of the aforesaid position that the parties have entered into compromise, the petition, as such, is accepted and interim directions issued vide order dated **17.01.2019** are made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioners shall appear and join the investigation as and when called upon to do

so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The present petition stands accepted accordingly.
