Petitioner Parneet Kaur Ghuman has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.008 dated 08.12.2018, registered at Police Station N.R.I., District Commissionerate Amritsar, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 201 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel and counsel for the complainant have appeared and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

The allegation against the present petitioner is mainly regarding conspiracy in this case. She has got registered DDR that the original Will has lost. The Will is stated to be year 1977 and she was married in the family in the year 1997. The case of the prosecution is that this Will has

been forged later on and this DDR was wrongly got registered and she in this way is a conspirator. Admittedly, the present petitioner, who is sister-in-law of the complainant is not the beneficiary nor she is an attesting witness in the Will.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 16.01.2019, passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. She is not required for custodial interrogation. No useful purpose would be served by sending her to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 16.01.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
