By this common order, I intend to dispose of both the aforesaid revision petitions i.e. CR Nos. 2149 and 2181 of 2018.

Both the parties are *ad idem* that instead of consolidating the suits, they be tried together as the suit property is the same and suit for injunction is filed by respondent nos. 1 to 4 represented by Mr. R.S. Chauhan, the other co-sharer.

In view of this, both the revision petitions are disposed of. The impugned order is modified to the extent that instead accepting plea of consolidating the suits, the suit for permanent injunction is directed to be decided by the same Court.
