This contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 19.04.2018 vide which a direction was issued to the respondents No.2 and 4 to look into the grievance of the petitioner. In case, any cognizable offence is found to have been committed, in such eventuality, respondent No.4 would be at liberty to act in accordance with law. If no such cognizable offence is found to have been committed, then the petitioner would be informed as per the parameters laid down in *Lalita Kumari vs. Govt. of U.P. (2014) 2 SCC (1)*.

Reply by way of affidavit of Mohit Handa IPS, Superintendent of Police Ambala, has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record. As per the said reply no cognizable offence is made out. It has also been conveyed to the petitioner that no cognizable offence is made out. The police report Annexure R-4 has been placed on record.

In view of the same, the contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stand discharged.

The petitioner is at liberty to avail the remedy as available to her in law in view of Annexure R-4.
