Present petition under Section 439 of the Criminal Procedure Code has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.1046 dated 28.12.2018 under Sections 323, 506, 427, 379-B, 307, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25, 54 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contended that the main accused in this case has not been arrested as yet. There are no allegations against the present petitioner that he had opened fire even. Moreso, it is a case of no firearm injury. The petitioner is in custody since 03.01.2019, trial of the case still to take some more time, so the petitioner be released on bail.

Having considered the above facts and the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 03.01.2019, trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bar any more, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Rajesh alias Raju is ordered to be admitted on regular bail on furnishing adequate bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned learned trial Judge/ Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate.
