Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C') for grant of pre arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.25 dated 18.02.2018, under Sections 302, 201 and 120-B Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur.

While issuing notice of motion, this court passed the following order on 22.01.2019:-

“Undisputedly, the petitioner is a juvenile and he has been ordered to be summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur for the commission of an offence punishable under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code, vide order dated 23.10.2018, but at the same time, his pre-arrest bail has been declined on the ground of maintainability being a juvenile.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks some time to assist the Court regarding the maintainability of the petition.

Adjourned to 14.02.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner may join the proceedings in terms of order dated 23.10.2018, passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur and he be released on interim bail till the next date of hearing i.e. 14.02.2019.”

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from HC Appar Singh has acknowledged that in terms of the previous order the petitioner has joined the proceedings and his presence is no longer required.

In view of above, the interim order dated 22.01.2019 is made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.
