By this petition, the petitioner is seeking direction to the respondents to consider him eligible for promotion to the post of TGT Urdu by taking into consideration his MA Urdu qualification with more than 50% marks, in place of prescribed qualification of BA with atleast 50% marks in Urdu.

Learned counsel for the petitioner refers to the instructions dated 25.03.2016 (Annexure P-5) and instructions dated 27.09.2016 (Annexure P-6) whereby the Education Department has clarified that if a candidate has higher qualification in the same line, as prescribed in the minimum qualification, he should be considered as eligible. The petitioner has done BA (Urdu) and MA (Urdu) and is seeking direction to the respondents to promote him to the post of TGT Urdu. However the case of the petitioner is not being considered as he did not secure 50% marks in Urdu in BA as per Appendix B of the Haryana School Education (Group C) State Cadre Service Rules, 2012.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that as per instructions dated 25.03.2016 (Annexure P-5) and instructions dated

27.09.2016 (Annexure P-6) having 50% marks in Urdu in MA make him eligible for promotion to the post of TGT Urdu.

A detailed legal notice dated 16.11.2018 (Annexure P-9) has been given in this regard.

He further contends that the case for promotion of similarly situated employees is under process.

This petition is being disposed of by giving direction to the respondents to pass speaking order on the legal notice dated 16.11.2018 (Annexure P-9) within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
