The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.284 dated 04.08.2018 registered under Sections 406, 420 IPC and Section 24 of Immigration Act at Police Station Nissing, District Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that although the case against the petitioner was not correct and was based on misunderstanding between the parties. However, the fact remains that as on today, the parties have already settled the dispute between them. Even the complainant/ victims have sworn in the affidavits that they do not have any dispute with the petitioner any more. It is also contended that the petitioner is in custody since 10.11.2018. It is further contended that there is no other case against the petitioner.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State submits that the offences against the petitioners are serious. The allegations are

regarding cheating three different persons for big amounts. It is further contended that the Police are not aware of any private understanding between the parties.

However, learned counsel representing the complainant and all the alleged victims does not dispute the fact that the parties have amicably settled the dispute between the parties.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioner be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/ sureties to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate.
