This is a civil revision that has been filed seeking to challenge the impugned order dated 18.02.2017 passed by the Addl. District Judge, Chandigarh whereby, mesne profits has been assessed at the rate of @ 3000/- per month w.e.f. 31.03.2016.

Notice of motion was issued in the matter for 01.08.2017 by an interim order dated 03.04.2017 and it was directed that the mesne profits be deposited @ ₹ 1500/- per month on the same terms and conditions as fixed by the Appellate Authority, Chandigarh vide its order dated 31.05.2017. The matter was posted for hearing on 17.05.2018, on which date there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner and it was reported by the office that notices could not be issued due to non-filing of process fee. It was directed that fresh notices be issued to the respondents on filing the process fee for 06.09.2018 and thereafter, the matter was adjourned for

31.01.2019.

As per office noting, process fee has not been filed as on date, resultantlly, notices could not be issued. Today again, there is no adequate representation on behalf of the petitioner. It is 3.00 p.m. and the matter has been called. It appears that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the present matter.

Dismissed for want of prosecution.
