This is 2nd petition for grant of regular bail in FIR No.152 dated 01.06.2017 under Section 21 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Nakodar, District Jalandhar.

After arguing the case for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition and submits that since the charges had been framed on 06.12.2017, custody of the petitioner is more than two years and out of total 14 prosecution witnesses, only 01 PW has been examined, therefore, a direction may be issued to the trial Court to conclude the trial within a time frame.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

The trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously preferably within a period of six months from today.

The Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural) is also directed to ensure that the prosecution evidence is concluded within a period of three months from today to enable the trial Court to conclude the trial within another three months thereafter.
