Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the respondent/plaintiff has filed an application before the Trial Court seeking withdrawal of his suit but since in the present petition, there is an interim order passed by this Court restraining the Trial Court from passing the final order in his suit the Trial Court is not permitting withdrawal of the respondent's suit.

Learned counsel for the petitioner/defendant does not dispute the above.

Once, the respondent/plaintiff has filed an application seeking therein to withdraw his suit and the petitioner/defendant has no objection to the same, in normal course, the Trial Court should have no objection in permitting the respondent/plaintiff to do so.

In view of the above, the present petition has been rendered

infructuous and is disposed of as such.

It is clarified that in case the respondent/plaintiff's suit is not permitted to be withdrawn by the Trial Court, the petitioner may revive the present petition.
