Present petition has been filed seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to promote the petitioner to the post of Head Ground Man Grade-III.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner is duly qualified and entitled for the said post and being eligible has priorly vested right to be considered for the said post before the same is advertised to general public.

3. Feeling aggrieved against non-consideration for the said promotion, the petitioner submitted a representation dated 21.03.2018 (Annexure P-3) to the Registrar, Panjab University. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that based on the said representation, respondent No.3-Director, Sports, P.U. Chandigarh recommended the case of the petitioner for promotion to the Head Ground Man Grade-III. Notwithstanding, the petitioner's case is not being processed as per the said recommendation. The same

necessitated the submission of another representation dated 28.09.2018 to the Panjab University through Director, Sports, but the same has not been adverted to till date.

4. Keeping in view the contents of the representation and the record appended thereto as also the contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner noted above, present petition is disposed of without issuance of notice or any further proceedings or pleadings. Respondent No.2 is directed to pass a speaking order on the representations submitted by the petitioner and also keeping in view the contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner as noted above. Let needful be done within a period of 06 weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. However, it is made clear that nothing observed or noted above shall be construed as an opinion on the merits of the case. The respondents are at liberty to decide the case of the petitioner in accordance with law.

6. Disposed of.
