This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.158 dated 16.4.2018, registered under Sections 302, 120-B, 147, 148, 149, 364 IPC at Police Barwala, Hisar.

Custody certificate dated 21.1.2019 by way of affidavit of Shamsher Singh Dahiya, Superintendent of Prison, Central Jail No.1 (Hissar)-Haryana has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State, the same is taken on record. Copy has been supplied to the opposite counsel.

As per the custody certificate the petitioner has undergone custody for 7 months and 10 days. The allegations against the petitioner are that he arranged the vehicle. Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner was named in the disclosure statement made by the co-accused in

custody even despite so much time no other evidence has been found against the petitioner and even challan is based on that disclosure statement.

On instructions from ASI Shish Karan learned DAG has accepted these factual assertions.

In the circumstances, keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner. Ordered accordingly. Bail to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
