HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has submitted the medical bills for reimbursement of the same. The details of the bills amounting to Rs.2,77,563/- have been given in the Paragraph 7 of the writ petition. He further states that due to the mala-fide intention of respondents No. 3 and 4, the bills have not been processed, at all, even after expiry of approximately 05 to 06 months.

He further states that the petitioner has already made a representation to the Director, Social Justice & Empowerment Department, Government of Haryana, on 18.07.2018 giving the description of the bills and requesting the release of the same.

Without going into the merits of the case and expressing any opinion about the entitlement of the petitioner, the Director, Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of Haryana, is directed to decide the entitlement of the petitioner for reimbursement of the medical bills, submitted by him, amounting to Rs.2,77,563/-.

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Let an appropriate decision be taken in this regard within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefit, the same shall also be released to him within a period of month thereafter.
