The petitioners are seeking direction to the respondents to ante-date their date of regularization w.e.f. 12.05.2005 instead of August 2012 to September 2018.

The petitioners were appointed in the year 1994-2002 as part time sweeper/peon/water carrier and their services were regularized after more than 12 years as per details given in para 2 of the writ petition and regularization order dated 07.08.2014 of one of the petitioners has been placed on record (Annexure P-2). The petitioners thereafter came to know that as per the seniority list (Annexure P-1), some of their co-employees who were juniors to them, have been given benefit of regularization w.e.f. 12.05.2005 and the regularization order of one Bhup Singh is at Annexure P-3.

A detailed legal notice dated 05.09.2018 (Annexure P-7) has been given referring to the judgments passed by this Court in ***CWP-18296-2014 Sanjay and others V/s. State of Haryana and others*** (Annexure P-4), ***CWP-14131-2016 Mukesh Kumar and others V/s. State of Haryana and others*** (Annexure P-5) and ***CWP-27566-2017 Satyawan and others V/s.***

State of Haryana and others (Annexure P-6), to the respondents to grant them parity after ante dating their date of regularization at par with their juniors.

At this stage, this petition is being disposed of by giving direction to the respondents to look into legal notice dated 05.09.2018 (Annexure P-7) and pass speaking order within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
