Complaint dated 03.01.2019 sent by Suman to Hon'ble the Chief Justice, has been taken on judicial side.

As per the complaint, the complainant has stated that his son Akashdeep and nephew Jasbir Singh Jassi have been kidnapped by somebody under planned conspiracy or might have been implicated in some false case or killed.

A detailed report has been called from the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, wherein it is stated that Akashdeep and Jasbir Singh Jassi were earlier nominated in a theft case bearing FIR No.166 dated 05.07.2018 under Section 379 IPC registered at Police Station Division No.4, Ludhiana. Apart from the aforesaid FIR, on 04.01.2019, on the basis of secret information, the aforesaid accused were apprehended along with stolen Bolero Jeep. During investigation of the accused, 6 other stolen cars, 5 motorcycles and one scooter make Activa were also got recovered. Besides this, 23 engines of motorcycles, 110 tyres of motorcycles, 40 fuel tanks of motorcycles, 43 shockers of motorcycles and 57 seats of motorcycles were

also got recovered. It is also stated in the reply that they were found involved in 47 theft cases, FIR numbers of which have been mentioned in the reply.

In view of above detailed reply submitted by the State, no further action is required in this matter.

Disposed of accordingly.
