Heard. Petitioner, namely, Jobanjit Singh, was challaned by police in FIR No. 66, dated 15.2.2012, under Sections 394, (379, 323, 411 IPC added later on) read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Amritsar City. Petitioner was declared a proclaimed person, vide order dated 12.2.2018, passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar. The case was ultimately decide on 17.2.2018. Now, petitioner has come before this Court for quashing FIR in question as well as order dated 12.2.2018, passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar, declaring him a proclaimed person.

So far as FIR in question is concerned, mere fact that co accused of petitioner have been acquitted by trial Court on the ground that they were not identified in the Court is no ground to quash FIR in question against petitioner. So far as order declaring petitioner a proclaimed person is concerned, petitioner is directed to surrender before trial Court and seek regular bail. If petitioner files an application for regular bail, same shall be decided by trial Court within three days.
