Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the impugned order was passed in the pcontext of the wheat crop which had to be harvested in the early part of the year 2018, and that now the property in question is completely under the control of his client and as such, the present Revision Petition is redundant to the extent of the prayer pertaining to restrain the respondent from selling the crop which had already been sold by him in the meantime.

He, therefore, prays for permission to seek recovery of the lease amount admissible to the petitioner from the respondent.

In view of the above submission, the Revision Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to seek appropriate remedy against the respondent in accordance with law.
