This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.132 dated 28.04.2018 registered under Sections 269, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Division No.5, Ludhiana.

Learned State counsel has filed custody certificate and on the basis of said custody certificate, at the very outset, she submits that more than 100 cases are pending against the petitioner and the investigation qua petitioner has not been completed so far.

Keeping in view the stage of investigation as the same has not been completed, no ground is made out to release the petitioner on regular bail.

The petition is accordingly dismissed.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to avail an appropriate remedy by considering the delay in presentation of challan.
