Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (*for short 'Cr.P.C.'*) for grant of bail, pending trial, to the petitioner in case FIR No.50 dated 19.06.2018, under Section 18 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sadar Kotkapura, District Faridkot.

Learned State Counsel has pointed out that entire prosecution evidence except Investigating Officer (I.O.) is over and now the case is fixed for 18.09.2019.

In view of above, no case for grant of regular bail to the petitioner is made out at this stage.

Faced with the situation, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not wish to press the present petition.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as not pressed.

However, learned trial Court is requested to conclude the testimony of I.O. on the date fixed or preferably within one week thereafter.
