ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.533 dated 30.10.2012, under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sonipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners were declared innocent during investigation and have been summoned to face trial in terms of Section 319 Cr.P.C.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 17.01.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the trial Court and in the event of their doing so, they were ordered to be released on interim bail on their furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Learned State counsel states that petitioners have surrendered before the trial Court and have been released on interim bail in terms of the order dated 17.01.2019.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for petitioners, the order dated 17.01.2019 granting interim bail to petitioners is made absolute.

The petition stands disposed of.
