Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed for issuance of directions to official respondent Nos.1 and 2 to take FIR No.268 dated 31.10.2018, under Sections 307, 323, 324, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur to its logical end.

In response to the notice of motion, issued by this Court, Status Report by way of affidavit dated 21.02.2019 of J. Elanchezhian, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur has been filed. The same is taken on record. Copy supplied to the opposite side.

Perusal of the affidavit reveals that after investigation in the matter, Section 307, IPC has been deleted and out of four accused, namely, Kuldeep Singh and Surinder Kaur have been found to be involved in the present case and investigation qua them is already complete. The affidavit

also reveals that remaining two co-accused, namely, Balbir Singh and Sukhwinder Singh have been found to be innocent.

In view of above, no further directions are required to be issued in the present case.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed off.

However, it will be open for the petitioner to take all his pleas before learned trial Court at the appropriate stage.
