On 19.11.2018, following order was passed:-

“Perusal of the record would show that the petitioner has prayed for maintenance under Section 18 of the Hindu Adoption and Maintenance Act. An application under Order 33 Rule 1 CPC for pursuing the suit as indigent person was also filed. Vide order dated 18.10.2011, interim stay regarding alienation of the suit property was granted by the trial Court, however the application under Order 33 Rule 1 CPC was dismissed in default on 16.02.2012. The application for restoration of the application under Order 33 Rule 1 CPC was filed on 21.02.2012, but vide order Annexure P-6, the suit itself is shown to have been decided on merits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would be

obligated to satisfy this Court as to whether anything survives in this revision petition or not?

Adjourned to 05.03.2019.”
