This is a petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the present petitioner in case FIR No. 45 dated 10.6.2018 under Sections 379-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Raja Sansi, District Amritsar (Rural).

As per the custody certificate filed in Court today, petitioner has undergone 06 months and 01 days.

It comes out that the allegations against the present petitioner are that he was driving the motor cycle whereas his co-accused Lovepreet Singh snatched one mobile phone from the complainant.

Since the disposal of the trial will take time, therefore, there is no ground for further detention of the petitioner. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his

furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to following conditions: -

- (1) Petitioner shall surrender his passport before the trial Court, if any, and shall not leave the country without prior intimation to the Court;
- (2) Petitioner shall not directly or indirectly give any inducement or threat or promise to any witness and
- (3) Petitioner shall attend the Court on each and every date of hearing before the trial Court and in case of his absence, trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail.

Petition stands allowed accordingly.
