INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a writ in the nature of *habeas corpus* directing respondents No.2 and 3 to get detenue-Pooja Rani, released from the illegal custody of respondents No.4 to 6.

Vide order dated 15.01.2019 passed by this Court, notice of motion was issued and respondent No.3-Station House Officer, Police Station Bhogpur, District Jalandhar was directed to visit the address of respondents No.4 to 6 and make enquiry as to whether detenue-Pooja Rani is residing there with her own consent or has been detained by the private respondents illegally and forcibly.

Heard.

In compliance of the order dated 15.01.2019, status report by way of affidavit of Inspector Naresh Kumar, SHO, Police Station Bhogpur has been filed in the Court today. Same is taken on record.

It is mentioned in the status report that search was made, however, detinue-Pooja Rani and respondent No.4-Varinder Kumar could not be found. In para No.8 of the status report, it is mentioned that on 25.01.2019, respondent No.3 received a letter from Pooja Rani and Varinder Kumar stating that they had solemnized marriage on 21.01.2019. They have also got DDR No.39 dated 25.01.2019 registered in this regard. They have also filed a civil suit for permanent injunction restraining defendants-Waryam Chand, Vijay Kumar, Karan Kumar, Labh Chand and Ashwani Kumar from interfering into their peaceful and married happy life.

In view of the reply submitted by respondent No.3, no further action is required in this matter.
