This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for releasing the detainee Tarannum Bano @ Tarannum from the illegal custody of respondent Nos.6 and 7.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel has appeared and filed the reply. He states that detainee Tarannum Bano @ Tarannum is residing with her parents as per her own wish and she has not been illegally detained by them.

Alleged detainee-Tarannum Bano @ Tarannum is also present in the Court. She states that she is aged about 20 years. Earlier, she was married with petitioner-Sunny Sharma. As the petitioner was harassing her, she gave an application to the Chandigarh police and the police gave a date of December 2018 for further proceedings. Meanwhile, the petitioner gave beatings to her and he also came to Ludhiana at her parents house. She further states that she is residing with her parents as per her own consent

and she wants to reside with them. She does not want to go with the petitioner and this petition has been filed to harass her.

In view of the statement made by detenue, the instant petition is dismissed with costs of ₹25,000/- to be paid by the petitioner to detenue-Tarannum Bano @ Tarannum within one month.

If petitioner fails to deposit the costs, then Registry is directed to get it recovered as land revenue to be paid to the detenue as per law.
