Challenge in the instant petition is to the communication dated 6.11.2017, Annexure P19, issued by the National Highway Authority of India to M/s L&T Panipat Elevated Corridor Ltd. as also the consequential communication dated 7.11.2017, Annexure P20, issued by M/s L&T Panipat Elevated Corridor Ltd. to M/s E-Star Network Services and further challenge is to the communication by way of E-mail dated 9.11.2017, Annexure P21, which has been issued by respondent No.3 to the present petitioner.

The controversy involves removal of advertisements on the project in question i.e. Panipat Toll Plaza. Apparently, the present petitioner was granted advertising and hoarding rights on the project by respondent No.3 i.e. M/s E-Star Network Services.

Having argued the matter at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the instant writ

petition with liberty to avail of any other alternate/efficacious remedy, as may be available to the petitioner in accordance with law.

Prayer is allowed.

Disposed of as withdrawn.
