INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.138 dated 15.03.2017, registered at Police Station Pehowa, District Kurukshetra, under Sections 302, 452 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner is not named in the FIR. There is only one fatal injury on the head and remaining injuries are abrasions only. The private witnesses have

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already been examined. Out of 29 prosecution witnesses, 12 witnesses have been examined so far.

The petitioner has been in custody since 21.08.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of case may take a long time.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail; without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and in view of the custody period, I find that no useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case. Therefore, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
