The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.174 dated 20.10.2018, registered under Sections 306 IPC, at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur.

The mother of the complainant had died by hanging. As per prosecution version, the petitioner, who is the wife of the complainant, had altercation with her mother in law (deceased). It is further alleged that the petitioner was doing nursing course at Sangrur and she lost her character and went astray and due to this tension, mother of the complainant committed suicide.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that no offence under Section 306 IPC is made out against the petitioner.

The petitioner is in custody for the last three months. The challan has already been presented. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody

any further.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner Harpreet Kaur is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of her absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel her bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure her presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) She shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
