LISA GILL, J.

This petition has been filed for setting aside impugned judgment dated 23.02.2016 passed by the learned Rent Controller, Chandigarh as well as judgment dated 06.04.2017 passed by the learned Appellate Authority, Chandigarh.

The petitioner, duly identified by his counsel, is present in Court. Respondent – Subhash Kumar is also present in Court. He furnishes his Aadhar Card and Voter identity card as proof of his identity. Photocopies thereof are taken on record subject to just exceptions.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties and the terms and conditions of the compromise have been re-drawn. Earlier compromise was drawn up on 23.01.2018 and now the parties have entered into a fresh compromise on 27.01.2019. It is submitted that though the year of compromise is incorrectly mentioned in the body of the said compromise as '2018', the said agreement was executed on 27.01.2019 and duly notarised on 24.04.2019. In view of the said compromise, it is submitted that the petitioner seeks to withdraw this petition. Compromise deed dated 22.01.2019, furnished in Court today

is taken on record subject to just exceptions.

Respondent – Subhash Kumar affirms and verifies the settlement arrived at between the parties in January, 2019. He identifies his signatures on the said document. Parties agree to abide by the terms and conditions of the settlement.

In view of the position as above, present revision petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
