The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.252 dated 27.09.2018 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 506, 365, 307, 325 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Chhainsa, District Faridabad (Annexure P-1).

The petitioners along with one Sunil are alleged to have armed with pistols, assaulted Ankit, Ashok @ Bhajji and Vijay when they were sitting with priest after doing aarti at Pushak temple. The accused are alleged to have fired gun shots. Thereafter, they beat up Vijay and put him in the car and after some distance they threw him out from the moving car. In this case, one person used 315 bore gun empty of which was recovered from the spot.

The State alleges that after the said occurrence, accused committed

another crime within a span of little more than half an hour. In this case, the complainant/victim are yet to be examined. Therefore, at this stage, there is no ground to grant bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the petition is dismissed with liberty to file fresh petition after the complainant, victim and eyewitness examined.
