Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.175 dated 28.10.2018 under Sections 399, 402 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Passiana, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, on receiving a secret information that some persons are present near Village Shermajra and are planning for dacoity. The police party conducted a raid and arrested four persons including the petitioner. It is stated that the petitioner was armed with iron rod and two other persons namely Gurjinder Singh and Gurbhej Singh were armed with .315 bore pistols and one Varinder Singh was armed with spring actuated knife. It is further submitted that the petitioner is first offender and is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Balbir Singh,

submits that the investigation is complete, challan stands presented and the same is yet to be committed to the Court of Sessions.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 28.10.2018; he is not involved in any other case and also the nature of recovery effected from him, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Petition is disposed of.
