It is averred by the petitioner that an order passed by the Sub Divisional Magistrate under Section 145 Cr.P.C. has been violated by the private respondents. Although, an FIR has been registered under Section 188 IPC, yet the police is not taking any action thereupon. A representation dated 21.11.2018 (Annexure P-4) in this regard has also been submitted but to no avail.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

Mr. Luvinder Sofat, learned AAG, Punjab, accepts notice. Four copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of day. Considering the nature of order being passed, no notice is required to be issued to respondents No.4 to 13.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the representation dated 21.11.2018 (Annexure P-4) and to take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
