Counsel submits that the petitioner had got registered FIR No.182, dated 19.08.2018, under Sections 354-A/323/427/147/149/341/506 IPC at Police Station Daresi, Ludhiana against the private respondents herein in relation to an alleged incident that took place on 18.08.2018.

The instant writ petition has been filed seeking protection of life and liberty of the petitioner on the assertion that the private respondents are threatening the petitioner to withdraw and resile from her earlier statement which had led to the registration of the FIR. It is asserted that the private respondents who happen to be neighbours of the petitioner are repeatedly harassing her and even threatening her.

Counsel submits that a number of representations have been filed before the authorities concerned but no action has been taken till date.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant petition with a direction to the SHO, Police Station Daresi, Ludhiana to examine the matter as also to assess the alleged threat perception voiced by the petitioner

and thereafter to take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted in accordance with law.
