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**GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)**

1. The petitioners have approached this Court for issuance of appropriate directions so as to protect their lives and liberty.
2. Learned counsel has submitted that petitioners No.2 and 3 had married on 14.05.2018, although the said marriage is not acceptable to the parents of petitioner No.2. Petitioner No.1-Amarjit Kaur is stated to be grandmother of petitioner No.2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that now the private respondents No.5 to 10 who are all relatives of petitioner No.2 are interfering into their lives and issuing threats to cause harm to them.

3. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur to look into the matter and to dispose of complaints Annexures P-1 to P4, expeditiously and in case, the allegations made therein are found to be well-founded then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest. It is further directed that in case, there is any genuine apprehension of threat to life and liberty of the petitioners, then adequate steps be taken so as to ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

A copy of this order along with copy of the complaints (Annexures P-1 to P-4) sent to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
