[1] After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press the revision petition but in view of the appeal having been filed against order dated 07.08.2018 (Annexure P-5), dismissing the application under Order 9 Rule 13 despite the plea that the petitioner could not put in appearance on account of having suffered a stroke and his son having disappeared in mysterious circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied if the learned Appellate Court is directed to decide the appeal, which is pending for arguments for 26.02.2019 expeditiously.

[2] In view of the innocuous nature of the prayer, I do not propose to issue notice to the respondents and dispose of the revision petition by directing the learned Additional District Judge, Patiala, to consider and
