The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 55, dated 29.05.2018, under Sections 379, 411, 420, 467, 468, 471, 473, 120 IPC, registered at Police Station Tapa, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he was selling stolen vehicle after forging the documents. The petitioner is in custody for over 9 months.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Pritpal Singh states that although investigation has been completed and 9 out of 39 prosecution witnesses have been examined. There are other cases pending against the petitioner and he has been convicted one of them and undergoing sentence in that case.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 9 months, I deem it to be a fit case to grant him the concession of regular bail as the conclusion of the trial is

likely to take some time.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
