HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J

In the present writ petition, the claim which is being made by the petitioner is that he got voluntarily retirement on 30.11.2015 and after the voluntarily retirement, the retiral benefits have not been released to him so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that even the salary for a period of 15 months, prior to the said date of voluntarily retirement, is also pending to be released to the petitioner. He further states that there is no justifiable reason with the respondents to withhold the same as there are/were no proceedings pending against the petitioner which would justify withholding of the same.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondent(s) with a legal notice dated 08.12.2018 (Annexure P-3) and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case, a time bound direction is issued to respondent No. 5 to decide the said legal notice by passing a speaking order.

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In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.5 to pass an appropriate speaking order on the legal notice dated 08.12.2018 (Annexure P-3) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled to any monetary benefits after the decision of the legal notice, the same should also be paid to him within three months thereafter.
