The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner for release of the benefit for which he is entitled for after his retirement on 31.05.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that there is no impediment for the release of the pensionary benefits as there are no proceedings pending against the petitioner but without any valid justification, the benefits are being withheld.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has made a representation dated 06.09.2018 (Annexure P2) to respondent No.4, which has not been decided so far. He further states that the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case, a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.4 to decide the same.

Keeping in view the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to pass an appropriate speaking order on the said representation dated 06.09.2018 (Annexure P2) within a period of three months from the receipt of a certified copy of this order.
