1. By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to respondents no.1 and 2 so as to hand over investigation pertaining to FIR No.58 dated 13.11.2018 under Section 67 of Information Technology (Amendment) Act 2008, Police Station Garhdiwal, District Hoshiarpur to respondents no.3 or 4.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that aforesaid FIR had lodged against the petitioner as a counter-blast to the FIR which had been lodged by petitioner against respondent No.9 i.e. FIR No.156 dated 13.11.2018 under Section 376 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur.

3. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to look into the matter and to dispose of representation, Annexure P-3 (although same is not addressed to respondent No.6) expeditiously and in case, the allegations made therein are found to be well-founded then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest.
4. A copy of this order along with copy of the representation (Annexure P-3) be sent to respondent No.6-Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
