AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 20.09.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.23340 of 2018. Operational part of the order is reproduced below:

“3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to consider the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the representation dated 20.07.2018 (P-9) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.”

Learned counsel for the respondent has produced copy of letter dated 09.07.2019 today in the Court, whereby benefits for

the period from 15.07.2016 to 03.05.2018 have been granted to the petitioner, same is taken on record-Marked 'A'. Copy of the same is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of copy of letter produced, no cause of action survives.

Disposed of as infructuous. Rule issued against the respondent is discharged.
