Present petition under Section 439 of the Criminal Procedure Code has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.156 dated 14.07.2013 under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code (Section 326 IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Sadar Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contended that the petitioner was earlier admitted to bail in this case and thereafter, he was declared as a proclaimed offender. Again, he was arrested in this case on 10.11.2018 and since then he is in custody and facing trial alongwith co-accused in the case.

Having considered the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner and the fact that the petitioner was earlier admitted to bail in this case and because of his absence, he was declared as a proclaimed

offender, he is in custody since 10.11.2018, trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bar any more, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-John alias Mauri is ordered to be admitted to regular bail on his furnishing adequate bail bond and **two surety bonds** to the satisfaction of concerned learned trial Judge/ Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate.
