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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Petitioners, who are stated to be major, claim that they have married against the wishes of their parents on 15.1.2019. The photographs of the marriage have been placed on file as Annexure-P-3 to Annexure-P-5. Certified true copies of Aadhar Cards, showing date of birth of both petitioners, have been placed on file as Annexure-P-1 and Annexure-P-2 respectively.

It is claimed that the petitioners have moved an application dated 16.1.2019 before the police authorities for protecting their life and liberty as they apprehend danger to their life from the private respondents, true typed copy of which is placed on file as Annexure-P-6.

In these circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala-respondent No.2,

to consider the application of the petitioners dated 16.1.2019 (Annexure-P-6) and assess the threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioners and if it is found that there is danger to the life of the petitioners, necessary steps be taken to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners. However, this order shall not be construed as a recognition of valid marriage between the parties.

Disposed of accordingly.
