Petitioner has prayed for a writ for direction that he be reinstated in service as Home Guard Volunteer. Admittedly, petitioner has been convicted for offence under Sections 304-A/279/337 IPC. According to learned counsel, revision against the said conviction is pending wherein sentence has been suspended. Due to same, petitioner is entitled to be reinstated as Home Guard Volunteer.

I find no merit in the plea. It is not disputed that there is no regular cadre of Home Guard Volunteers existing at the moment. Petitioner has no vested right to be appointed as such.

Dismissed.
