Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C') for grant of pre arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.503 dated 03.10.2018, under Sections 148,149,323,325,452 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Model town, Rewari District Rewari.

While issuing notice of motion, this court passed the following order on 21.01.2019:-

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from SI Rohtash Singh

has acknowledged that in terms of the previous order the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required in this case.

In view of above, the interim order dated 21.01.2019 is made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.
