The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.2 and 3 for protection of their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6, as they have married against the wishes of private respondents.

Learned State counsel on instructions has apprised the Court that the statements of the petitioners and private respondents have been recorded separately. The petitioners in their statements have expressed no threat to their married life whereas the private respondents in their statements expressed no objection to the alleged marriage between the petitioners. The statements have been produced before the Court and taken on record.

In view of the above, the alleged threat has vanished and the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
