Heard. Petitioners seeks quashing of FIR No. 106, dated 25.10.2018, under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur, on the basis of compromise.

Allegations against petitioner No. 2 Balbir Singh are that he claims himself to be President of Congress party and opened his office. He took Rs. 1,50,000/- and two tola gold in the name of Railway Minister with a promise to get job to complainant in Railways. Later on, he sent some fake documents through Whatsapp to show that he is fulfilling his promise.

The allegations are of serious nature. Getting money in the name of Railway Minister to provide a job in Railways and creating false documents is offence against State. There is no ground to quash FIR in question. Petition is dismissed.
