Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to register FIR under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 506 IPC against respondents No.4 to 6 and his companions.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the purpose would be achieved if respondent No.2—Superintendent of Police Sonapat, District Sonapat, is directed to look into complaint dated 25.12.2018 (P-4) moved by the petitioner, in a time-bound manner.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, but without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2—Superintendent of Police Sonapat, District Sonapat, to decide the complaint dated 25.12.2018 (P-4) by passing a speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
