The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 14.12.2018, vide which, direction was issued to the respondents to look into the grievance of the petitioner and pass appropriate orders, in accordance with law, with respect to release the amount/grant to the various government schools for providing free of cost uniform to the students who belong to SC/ST category and even those from BPL families and girls studying in Class Ist to 8th particularly as the winter session has set in and the time is in the essence of the situation.

Short reply by way of affidavit of respondent No.2 filed in Court is taken on record. Copy given to the petitioner. As per para nos.5 and 6 of the said reply, schools uniforms have already been supplied to 11,64,678 students out of 12,68,120 till 29.04.2019 which amounts to 91.84% and work of distributing of school uniforms to remaining is under process and same will be distributed within short time.

In view of the same, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

In case the respondents stop the said distribution in any manner, the petitioner will be at liberty to avail remedy as available to him, in accordance with law.
