Present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'Cr.P.C.') is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.67 dated 04.04.2018 under Section 420, 406, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, contended that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and is not required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 13.02.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.

Learned counsel representing the applicant-complainant contended that a sum of Rs.4,20,000/- has been deposited by the petitioner as per Court order and the same amount be released to the applicant-complainant.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contended that he has no objection to the release of the amount to the applicant-complainant, but that should be subject to the decision of the final litigation in this case.

In view of the above, the present application filed by the applicant-complainant is accepted and the amount of Rs.4,20,000/- is ordered to be released to the applicant-complainant against proper receipt and verification and release of said amount shall be subject to the final outcome to the litigation.
